

IS YOUR COMPANY READY TO EXPORT?

10 self-checks before you file for the fast-track export permit — Resolution No. 875, the Drone Deal mechanism. Every unticked item is a stop before you file.

☐ **01 Registered with the export-control service**

You're registered as a subject of international transfers.

☐ **02 Product / technology identified**

Classified by nomenclature: military or dual-use.

☐ **03 Internal export-control unit certified**

Your in-house export-control service is built and certified.

☐ **04 Cabinet authority — or the exemption**

Manufacturer + state-contract performer / on the registry → exempt. Or you hold the authority.

☐ **05 Counterparty is clean**

Buyer, UBO, intermediaries, subsidiaries — not sanctioned, no ties to the aggressor state.

☐ **06 Importer guarantees in hand**

State importer guarantees and an end-user certificate are in place.

☐ **07 Product isn't critical**

It's not on the critical-goods list.

☐ **08 Defense need cleared**

No state-customer intent to buy — or written supply guarantees for the Armed Forces.

☐ **09 Country on the Drone Deal list**

The importing country is a partner state.

☐ **10 Payment economics work**

The 20 % / 30 % fee is built into the contract's financial model.

FEE 20 % — goods · 30 % — components. Minimum contract for goods — from **UAH 15M** (≈ €293K). Proof of payment is filed with the application, before the decision.

NOT SURE ABOUT EVEN ONE ITEM?
